# **SEGUE Ministries Applicant Information**

#### **Vision Statement**

A community of young adults responding to the love of God through worship, missions, and discipleship.

#### **Internship Profile**

As followers of Christ, we have been called to the ministry of reconciliation, to care for those in need in our community, and to be equipped for good works through the teaching of others and the study of Scripture. SEGUE is not only comprised of discipleship and ministry, but also strives to convey a deeper understanding of worshiping our Father and provides regular opportunity for immediate ministry experience.

WORSHIP – In response to the character and hand of God, we seek to more fully know him and, in turn, to also better praise him. Within SEGUE is a specific course on worship and periods of special prayer emphases. A prayer room is also on site for devoted time of prayer and worship. A goal of SEGUE is to have songwriter groups in which those who desire to express their praise in new song can develop their message with others.

MISSIONS – In obedience to the call to share the good news of Christ with all people and nations, interns are shown the need not only exists across borders, but also in the home community at our doorstep with nearby refugees. This particular approach to missions for SEGUE is not only excellent stewardship, but also utilizes an effective mission strategy, that is, through building genuine relationships over an extended period of time.

DISCIPLESHIP – Spiritual formation is the goal of discipleship in SEGUE through classes, small groups, and the practice of personal spiritual disciplines. Christian leadership principles will not only be discussed, but also utilized in ministry. A strong desire of SEGUE is that as the year continues, interns will have the opportunity to also disciple new believers.

COMMUNITY – The number of participants will be kept relatively small for the purpose of building and maintaining a strong community environment where experiences and discoveries are shared. According to the various interests and desires of the interns, each intern will also meet regularly with small focus groups.

#### **Financial Guidelines**

The SEGUE internship is a valuable ministry training experience that will impact all areas of life. Why not invest nine months of your life in a way that will richly enhance your life both now and in many years to come, no matter where the Lord may lead you?

The internship is \$8,500 for the year and includes room, board, utilities, wireless internet, washer/dryer use, training classes, transportation to refugee ministry, and some training materials, as well as access to the prayer room, recording studio, swimming pool, 330 acres of land, etc.

It does not include transportation to and from work, personal health insurance, certain training materials (not to exceed \$75), green tea lattes, etc.

In order to cover the expense, you are encouraged to work 10 hours a week and raise support from family, friends, church, and ministry partners. The discipline of working a part-time flexible job is a great way to create additional ministry opportunities, as well as experience to add to your resume. SEGUE will provide you with a list of part-time employers who hire SEGUE interns. SEGUE will also offer tips and recommendations to aid in your support raising.

SEGUE emphasizes good stewardship and a mission strategy of reaching people in our home community over a extended length of time. We do believe this aspect of missions is often neglected, however we continue to affirm the value of mission trips as well. Therefore, you will also have the option to participate in a mission trip at the end of the program. Should you decide to participate, you would raise support for the trip throughout the year.

Upon acceptance into SEGUE, interns will submit a non-refundable deposit according to the date of receipt. The Early Bird Special is for those who are accepted and submit a deposit of \$200 by June 1. The remaining deadlines are as follows: July 1 - \$300; August 1 - \$400; September - \$500." Payment options are available.

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#### Sabine Creek Ranch Statement of Faith and Values

WE BELIEVE in the inspired and inerrant sixty-six books of the Word of God. It is the final authority on all essential matters of the faith and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness.

Born of a virgin, he lived a sinless life on earth, was crucified on the cross as a substitution for the sin of mankind, reconciling all to himself who would believe and trust in him. After three days he then rose from the dead, ascended into heaven, and now lives again in heaven at the right hand of the Father until the appointed time when he will again return to set up his kingdom on earth.

WE BELIEVE that salvation is by the grace of God, through faith, and in Christ alone. There is nothing anyone can do to obtain his/her own salvation. Salvation is carried out through the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit in the life of each believer as he/she responds in obedience and lives a life worthy of the calling of Christ.

WE BELIEVE in the indwelling of the Holy Spirit in the life of every believer. He equips and gifts each believer according to the grace of God and for the purpose of service and ministry, ultimately the glory of God.

WE BELIEVE in the universal and the local church. Every believer is a part of the body of Christ, is called to be involved with a local body of believers, and is equipped for ministry through the gifting of the Holy Spirit.

WE BELIEVE in the mission of God to reconcile all people of all nations to himself. Today this is primarily carried out through the church and the followers of Christ therein. All in Christ have been given this ministry of reconciliation and are called to live lives of purity, love, grace, and truth before all men, unashamedly representing and proclaiming the gospel of God. This is the passion of God, the heart of Christ, and the continuing work of the Spirit.

#### **Guidelines for Segue Applicants**

**Flexibility**: You are applying to embark on a new adventure and to be a charter participant of SEGUE! Many great things are in store! However, as this is the first year of SEGUE, we also kindly request your flexibility and gracious suggestions throughout the program.

**Teachability**: As the very nature of SEGUE largely revolves around various training sessions, it is necessary that interns approach the program with a willingness, desire, and commitment to learn. This includes, but is not limited to, involvement in session discussions, completing any preparation exercises/assignments before each session, and respecting fellow interns as they are also learning.

**Ministry Involvement**: Regular ministry opportunities prearranged by the SEGUE staff are an essential component of the SEGUE program. By applying for the program, each intern affirms he/she has a heart for ministry and is therefore expected to participate with excellence in the appointed ministry. As a part of the SEGUE community, each intern and staff member will have the opportunity to both serve in his/her giftings, as well as be stretched in new areas. Each intern is expected to participate as an active part of this community in ministry.

**Breaks:** Extended breaks for holidays, including Thanksgiving and Christmas, are built into the SEGUE program. There will also be personal break time away from the SEGUE program, ministry, and work.

**Dating**: SEGUE staff does not discourage participation in SEGUE to those who are already in a dating relationship. However, we do strongly encourage any such participant to give balanced attention and involvement in SEGUE while maintaining a healthy relationship. The SEGUE community must be maintained throughout the duration of the program. For the sake of maintaining a healthy community environment, we ask interns to honor the request of postponing any new dating relationships among the SEGUE interns until after the program has been completed in the spring.

**Personal Conduct**: As a follower of Christ and minister of the gospel, each intern is expected to be above reproach in his/her personal speech, conduct, and appearance. As message bearers of purity and grace, interns should live in a way that edifies both fellow interns and those who are off-site. We also request that particularly in ministry situations, interns keep in mind the importance of dressing modestly and in a way so as not to offend or cause distraction.

**Health**: Each intern is required to care for his/her own personal health insurance and medical needs. Neither SEGUE nor Sabine Creek Ranch are responsible for medical issues that may arise.

**Work**: Interns are encouraged to work 10 hours per week in order to both supplement their supportraising and to implement their discipleship and ministry training in another "real-world" environment. Prior to arrival, interns will be presented with a list of suggested employers in order to guide the job search process. Holding a job, however, is not to be a primary concern during the SEGUE program. Although each intern should perform his/her job with excellence and punctuality, it must fall within certain time frames, so as not to distract from the program itself nor the SEGUE community environment.
